- Organizing fundraising campaigns

Rationale: Everyone who completed the fall 2018 survey said the Library should continue with the Expansion and Renovation Project

Focus Area - Library Resources

Enhance services and programs to meet the needs of the community by:

- > Developing a series of enrichment programs for adults
- Providing year-long online reading program activities for all ages
- > Increasing the number of family-oriented programs throughout the year

Rationale: Participants in the fall 2018 survey and focus groups indicated a need for more adult informational and educational programs, especially those of interest to men of the community. Also of importance was the need to continue and increase the number of family programs.

Focus Area - Communication

Improve methods for promotion and publicity by:

- > Utilizing options for email newsletter and program alerts
- > Using multiple social media platforms
- > Establishing community partnerships

Rationale: Lack of communication was the underlying issue when discussing needed improvements

Focus Area - Evaluation

Assure consistent monitoring of Library Services 2019 through 2021

- > Provide sufficient continuing education opportunities for board and staff
- Expect regular staff performance evaluations
- > Begin process of planning for years 2022-2024 by May 2021

Assessment Goals

Internet Connectivity – The Library will continuously assess the effectiveness and reliability of the current ISP and will plan for upgrades when suitable enhancement or replacement is identified.

Public Access – The Library provides six public access computers and a WiFi hot spot. Patrons initiate their computer sessions by logging on with their library account. Visitors are given a guest pass. The Library will frequently review options for computer management solutions to ensure the most efficient and cost effective service

Social Media – Library staff will keep the Library website, Face Book, Twitter and Pinterest accounts updated with regularly postings at least weekly. Staff will also actively seek other outlets for Library online presence.

Tech Support – The Library will use the Northeast Kansas Library System [NEKLS] Tech Team as the primary tech support as long as that benefit is available.

The Silver Lake Library budget includes a line item for Continuing Education. Library staff are encouraged to attend annual tech training events such as NEKLS Innovation Day. In addition, the annual staff in-service day will include tech training. Staff will complete a Technology Proficiencies Checklist annually. Training events will be geared toward filling the knowledge gaps. A Basic Technology Proficiency requirement will be determined and each staff will be expected to meet that requirement.
